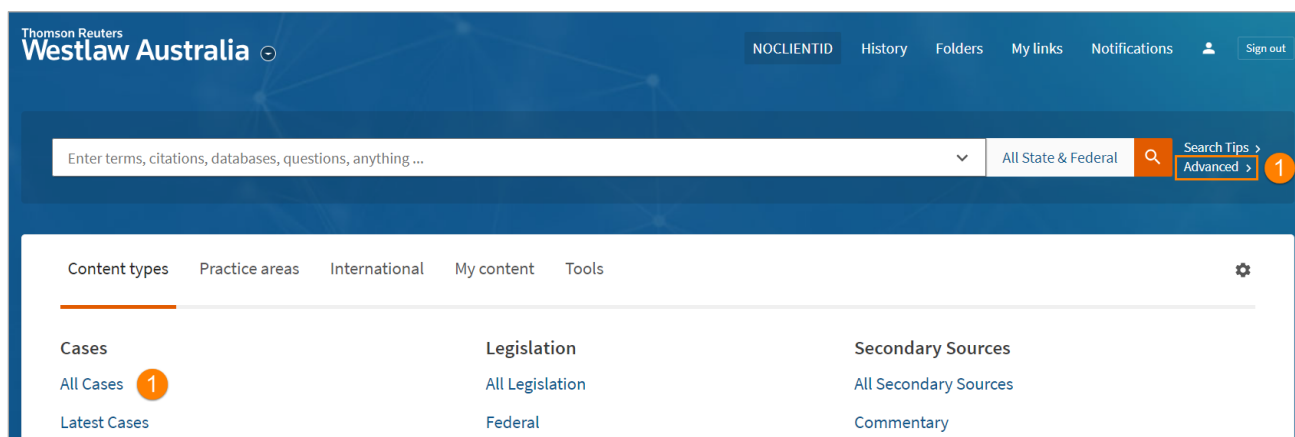




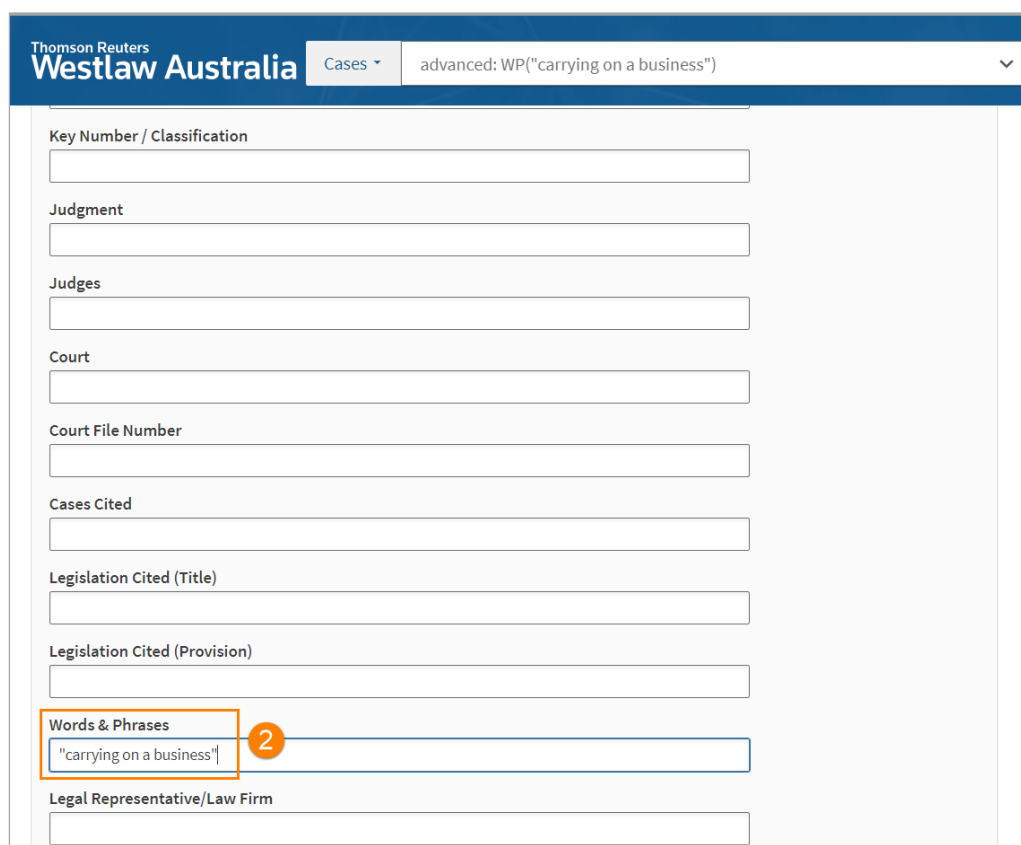
Finding cases judicially considering a word or phrase

You can quickly find cases where the judge considers the meaning of a word or phrase, using the Cases Advanced search template.

1. On the homepage, select **All Cases** and then click the **Advanced** link to the right of the search bar.



2. Scroll down to the **Words and Phrases** field and type your search terms. If you are looking for a phrase, use quotation marks to search for the phrase and not the individual words.



- On the results page, click on the phrase in each result to jump to the **Words and Phrases Judicially Considered** section in the case document.
