
What's Market User guide

What's Market provides information and analysis on recent public company transactions, and allows you to create comparison reports highlighting key deal terms.

Getting started

To visit the What's Market homepage click on **"What's Market"**, listed under the Resources tab on the Practical Law Australia homepage or under Resources in the Browse Menu.

From the What's Market homepage you can browse by **deal type** or search for deal summaries using the search bar.



Access recently published deals on the right of the screen.

Read market analysis produced by our expert legal writing team under the What's Market analysis heading **(coming soon)**.



Browse and compare summaries under the Deal Types heading.

Navigating: Browsing deals

From the What's Market landing page, click on a deal type to begin.

Refine your results by Industry, Country, Listing Structure, and more, using the filters on the left of the screen.

You can also create a graph to display deal information visually using the **"Create graph"** icon on the top right of the search results.

Navigating: Searching deals

Use the search bar to run a keyword search either from the What's Market landing page, or after browsing toa particular deal type.

Filters on the left hand screen allow you to refine search results.

You can also create a graph to display deal information visually using the **"Create graph"** icon on the top right of the search results.

Compare deal summaries

How to compare deals:

A. Select a deal type from the What's Market landing page (e.g. IPOs).

B. Use the tick boxes to select the deal summaries you wish to compare or tick the **"Select all"** option if you wish to compare all the summaries on the page (up to a maximum of 100).

C. Select the "Compare" button.
