

## Westlaw February Release Now Live!

The February 2019 Westlaw AU release is now live! The release focuses on improving case law research by providing access to case information and creating a seamless flow from FirstPoint to other secondary sources.

This release includes but is not limited to the following items:

- 1) The case information will be repositioned to the top of the document page and the right-hand pane.

- 2) We simplified "FirstPoint Classifications" and "Digest Summaries" into a combined view, with the ability to toggle display via the "Digest Notes" and "Classifications only" radio buttons.

3. We have introduced a new table view for Cases Citing and Cases Cited information to improve readability. This table format includes sorting and filtering options such as Courts, Types of Treatments, Title, Citations, Judgment Date and Citing Count.
