Objectives

This Webinar covers searching cases by using the Key Number System, Natural Legal Language and the type-ahead feature in new Westlaw.

This session will also demonstrate how results can be narrowed using refine and filter techniques.

- Introduce the Key Number System to locate cases on a specific point of law.
- Locate the litigation history and citing reference information.
- Conduct a topic-based search.
- Navigate and refine search results by applying filters.
- Print, email and download judgments.
- Annotate documents and save content to folders.
- Follow a case using KeyCite Alert.
