MEMORANDUM.

1936.

January 1.—The HONOURABLE SIR GEORGE EDWARD RICH, K.C.M.G.,
one of the Justices of the High Court of Australia,
was appointed a member of the Privy Council.

THE LATE SIR FRANK GAVAN DUFFY.

On 4th August 1936, at the sittings of the High Court in Sydney, STARKE, DIXON, EVATT and McTIERNAN JJ. being present, the following observations were made by STARKE J. :—

The Chief Justice regrets that he is unable to be present this morning.

Since the last sitting of this Court the Chief Justice and we have heard with sorrow of the death of SIR FRANK GAVAN DUFFY the late Chief Justice of the Court.

SIR FRANK GAVAN DUFFY was one of the oldest members of the legal profession in Australia. There are few, indeed, who can equal the length of his experience or who can rival it in variety of legal service. He was called to the Bar in the year 1874. He had a leading practice first in the County Court, then in the Supreme Court, and subsequently also in the High Court when this Court was established. In each of these jurisdictions he successively won distinction as an able advocate, skilled alike in handling witnesses and in legal argument. When Sir John Madden, Chief Justice of Victoria, died, SIR FRANK referred to his old friend as a formidable legal gladiator. The same phrase may very aptly be applied to our late Chief Justice.

SIR FRANK was truly learned in the law and some books which he published were for many years of great assistance to practitioners. As a lecturer at the University of Melbourne he helped to train many members of the profession.

After a highly successful career at the Bar he was appointed a Justice of this Court in 1913, and was appointed Chief Justice in 1931, resigning in October 1935. His work as a Judge gave full scope to his legal knowledge and to the acute logical intellect which was responsible for so much of his success. The record of his judicial work is to be found in the reports of the decisions of this Court.

He had a large acquaintance with men and affairs and did not allow the burden of his work to prevent a full enjoyment of life. He was welcomed in many circles for his quick wit and was well known for his great vitality. We sincerely mourn his death and we express our deep sympathy with Lady Gavan Duffy and the members of his family.
