THE LATE SIR ISAAC ISAACS

THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR ISAAC ALFRED ISAACS, P.C., G.C.M.G., formerly a Justice and Chief Justice of the High Court of Australia died at Melbourne in the State of Victoria on 11th February 1948, aged 92 years.

On 11th February 1948, at the first subsequent sittings of the High Court, LATHAM C.J., RICH, STARKE, DIXON, McTIERNAN and WILLIAMS JJ. being present, the following observations were made by LATHAM C.J. :—

LATHAM C.J.—I ask all present to rise.

We have learned with sorrow of the death of Sir ISAAC ISAACS, former Chief Justice of this Court. He had a most distinguished career at the Bar and in the Parliaments of Victoria and the Commonwealth. He was a leading member and the last survivor of the Federal Convention which framed the Commonwealth Constitution, which he afterwards did so much to interpret and apply.

He was appointed as a Justice of this Court in 1906 and as Chief Justice in 1930, retiring in 1931, when he became Governor-General of the Commonwealth. He was a man of wide learning, not only in law, but in other branches of human knowledge. He discharged his duties as a Judge with indefatigable industry, and his judgments constitute a most valuable and distinguished contribution to the development of the law.

We express our sincere sympathy with the members of his family in their bereavement.

DR. EVATT, K.C. (Attorney-General of the Commonwealth).—If Your Honour pleases, on behalf of the Bar, may I say that we endorse all that Your Honour has said and extend our sympathy to SIR ISAAC'S relatives.

May I add, Sir, that in view of the record to which Your Honour has so briefly referred this morning, the name of SIR ISAAC ISAACS will always be remembered as that of one of the greatest of Australians.
