### Keep Lists and Hide details

The **Keep List** in Westlaw Precision Australia will allow you to quickly bookmark up to 50 documents from your search results. This provides a quick method to identify relevant documents related to your research that can be viewed later.


The **Hide details** feature allows you to minimise documents displayed in your search results that have already been reviewed. The hidden case will remain hidden across multiple searches to avoid reviewing the same result twice.

### How to use Keep Lists

You can add content to your Keep List from within a document or from a search results list by clicking the Keep List icon .


Note: Add up to 50 documents. The documents stay in the Keep List until you delete them.

1. From the search results list, click the **Keep List** icon, to the right of the document title to save to your Keep List.





2. A notification window will appear to confirm the item has been added to your Keep List. Select View Keep List from the notification window or select the Keep List icon at the top of your results list to view the full list of items.





3. To access your Keep List, click the Tools tab or Tools menu and select Keep List.









#### How to use Hide Details

The hide details feature allows you to minimise documents displayed in your search results that you have already reviewed. Only when you log out and log back in will the results appear as normal, with no documents hidden.

1. When reviewing documents from the search results, if a document is not relevant to your research, you can hide this result by clicking the oupward chevron.



The hidden document will appear grayed out with fewer details. The case will remain hidden across multiple searches to avoid reviewing the same result twice. If you want to unhide, click the down arrow.
