# Forms and Precedents

The Forms and Precedents collection comprises over 3,000 expertly drafted precedents, statutory forms and checklists, and practical commentary.

This guide shows methods to find a forms or precedents, how to download documents and completed using Microsoft Word.

Westlaw Australia contains precedents from three separate publishers:

- a) ACP which is an abbreviation for Australian Commercial Precedents.
- b) NSW Precedents and
- c) Victorian Precedents.





#### How to Browse a Precedent Collection

1. From the Westlaw Australia homepage, under Secondary Sources, click Forms and Precedents.




2. Click the required precedent collection from the list e.g., ACP Trust Precedents.



- 3. Click "Add to Favourites" to create a shortcut to a Precedents collection you may use regularly.
- 4. Click "Update Summary" for information on the latest updates.


  Note: Precedents will be updated to maintain currency in line with legislative changes, case law developments and any other relevant considerations.
- 5. Browse the collection by clicking the + signs e.g., Discretionary Trust Deed Note: Content is displayed by document type e.g., Discretionary Trust Deed, Securities Trust Deed, Trust Stamp Duty Declaration.
- 6. Click the title to open the document e.g. TP001- Discretionary Trust Deed (Appointer and Guardian).




# How to locate a document using the Precedents Index

You can use the index to find a list of documents displayed by topic and form type.

1. From the homepage click Forms and Precedents from Secondary Sources then select NSW Precedents – Family Law. To open the Precedents Index, click the title.




- 2. The **Tip**: provides search tips.
- 3. You can download the Index as a Word document.
- 4. To download a precedent, click the identifier code, e.g. FAM3.




### How to search for Forms and Precedents using plain language

You can conduct a plain language search, to find relevant precedents without using connectors.


1. From the homepage, type the name of precedent topic e.g., employment precedent, then select the title from the suggested content drop-down menu e.g., ACP Employment Precedents.



2. From the Precedents collection page, type terms using plain language in the search bar, then click Search. The example below shows Westlaw searching all "ACP Employment Precedents" for confidentiality and policy.




- 3. Search results are listed by relevance. Documents with most hits, proximity of search terms, and search terms found in the title, are at the top of the list.
- 4. Use post search filters or Search within results on the left, to refine search results.




#### How to Search Forms and Precedents using Terms and Connectors

Terms and connectors can be used to provide precise and efficient content searches.

- 1. To search <u>all</u> precedents, click Forms and Precedents, under Secondary Sources on the home page.
- 2. Click "Search Tips>" for a list of connectors you can use.
- 3. Type "joint venture" /5 agreement in the search bar then click Search button. This finds precedents where the phrase "joint venture" is within five words of agreement.




4. Use the **post search filters** on the left to refine the results in different ways **e.g.**, **Practice Area**. The Practice Area filter lists practice areas where the documents appear **e.g.**, **Commercial**, **Contract**, **Banking** & **Financial Services**.




#### **Document Features**

The following features are available in the precedents.

- 1. User Guide: Provides a Template User Guide to help maximise the functionality of the template.
- 2. Last Review: Provides information about the currency of this document.
- 3. Table of Contents: Use the Table of Contents on the left to navigate between documents.




- 4. Search: Click the Search icon and enter your search term/s then click the Search button to search within the document.
- 5. Reading Mode: Click Reading Mode to view the document in Reading Mode for a more streamlined reading experience.
- 6. **Download:** To download the precedent, click on the **Document Delivery Icon** and select **Download**.



7. **Download in Word:** Some precedents will also have a Microsoft Word icon that allows you to download an editable document to Microsoft Word.
