



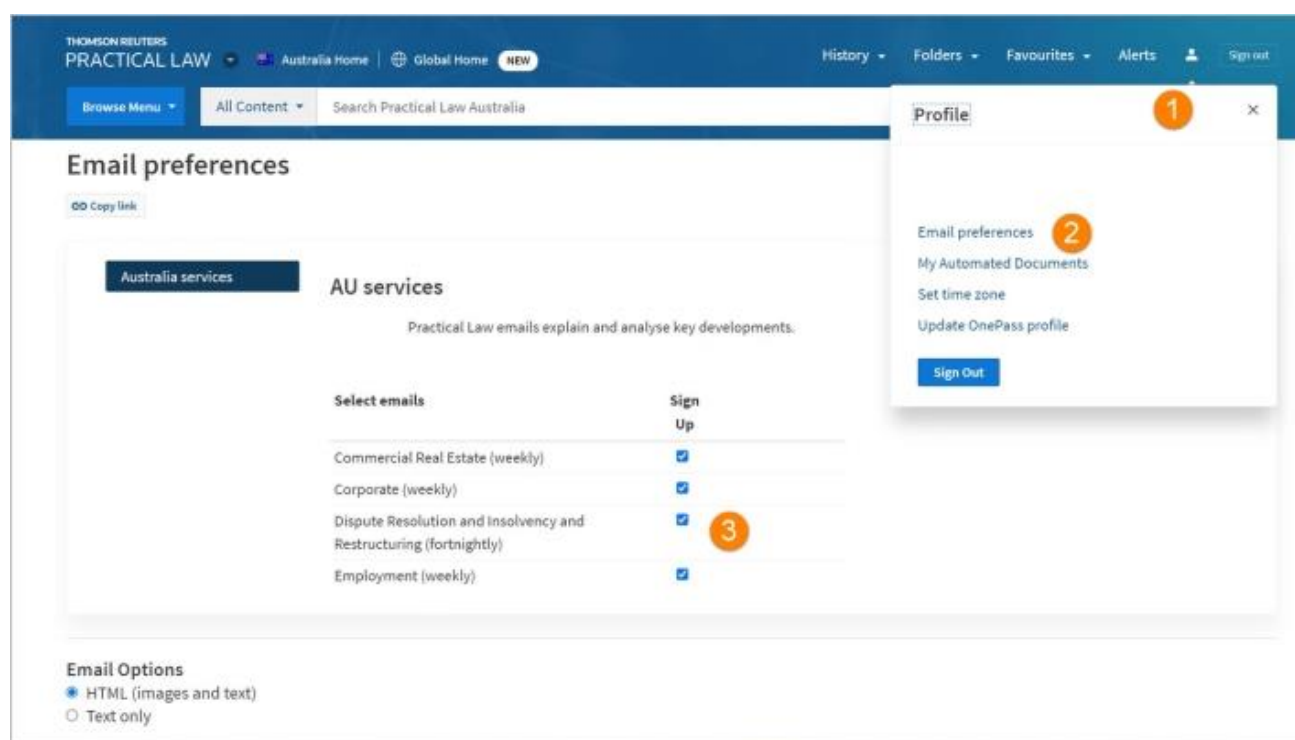
### Current Awareness alerts and RSS feeds

#### Current awareness alerts

Practical Law Australia publishes weekly/fortnightly email alerts, outlining new cases, legislative changes, regulatory decisions and details of new content for the Commercial Real Estate, Corporate, Employment and Dispute Resolution/Insolvency & Restructuring practice areas. These are free and part of your subscription.


1. To subscribe, click on the **Profile** icon on the top right of the screen.




2. Select Email preferences from the drop down menu.
3. Tick the Practice Area boxes required then click Save at the bottom of the screen.

## RSS Feeds

You can set up RSS feeds for legal updates for the Company Law, Corporate Transactions and Employment practice areas.

1. To access the feed, click on the practice area link from the homepage.
2. Click on the RSS icon  on the right-hand side, next to Legal Updates.
3. This will take you to a page explaining RSS feeds and how to set up practice area feeds.
