


Searching and browsing books


This guide shows you how to search and browse books on Westlaw. Books are law textbooks available in edition format.

Searching books

1. Search the collection of **books** from in the **Secondary Sources** menu.




- 2. To search multiple books, tick the book titles that you want to search.
- 3. Type search terms using plain language or terms and Boolean connectors in the search bar.



4. To search an individual book, type search terms using plain language or terms and Boolean connectors in the search bar.









Browsing books

5. Browse the collection of **books** from in the **Secondary Sources** menu.




- 6. Click on the book title to browse. Click the 'i' icon to view more information about the book.
- 7. Use the left-hand filter menu to refine books by topic, jurisdiction or use words in the title.

- 9. Once you are in a Book, click the + symbols to open chapters.
- 10. Click on a heading to view the text.
- 11. You can also browse by using the index in the same way as using a hard copy book.
