

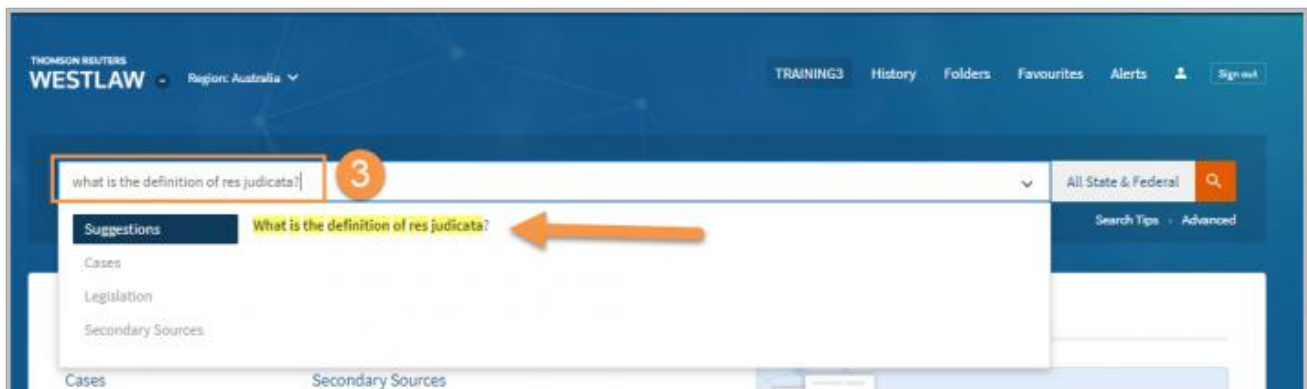
Using Law Summaries

Law summaries are suggested answers to common legal questions sourced directly from relevant and authoritative case law.

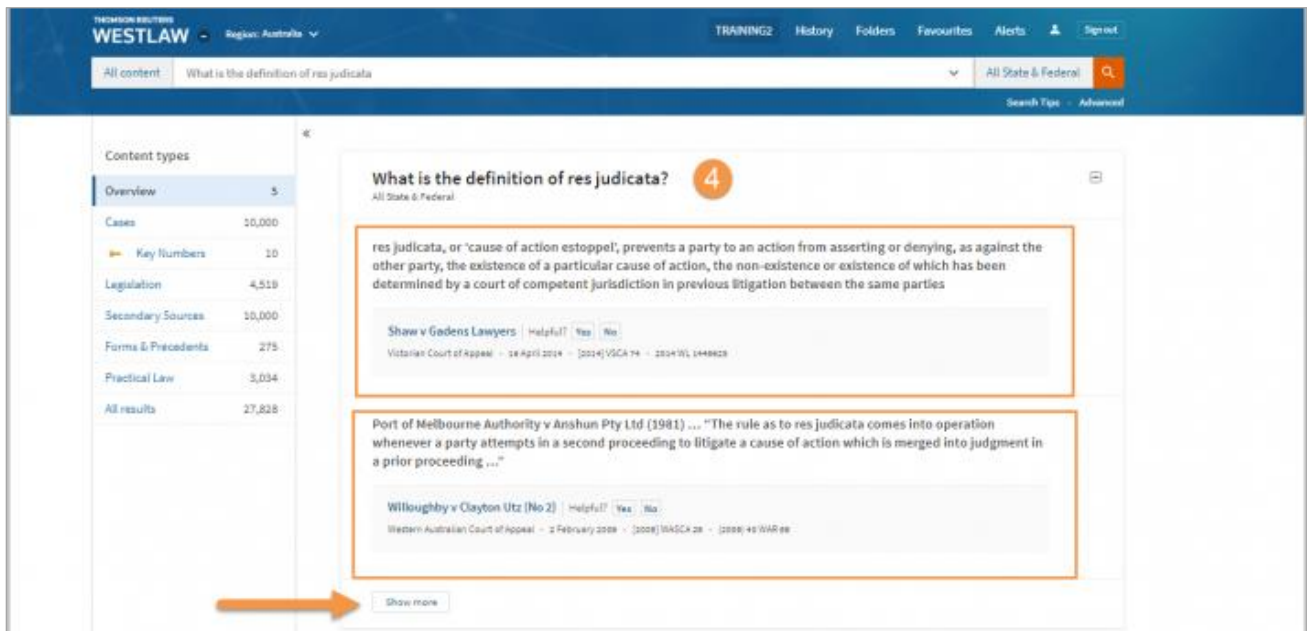
1. Type a keyword(s) into the global search bar, e.g., Agency or Res Judicata
2. Choose a suggested legal question from the drop-down list.



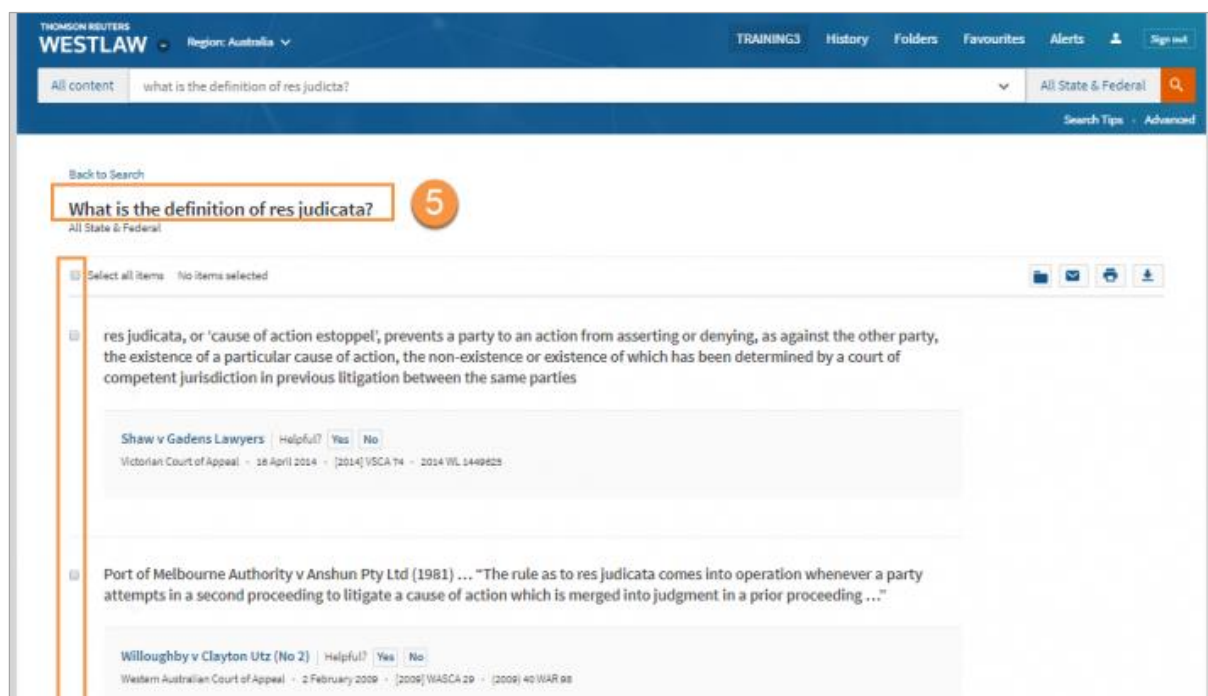
3. Alternatively, type in a direct legal question and select the question from the drop-down.



4. The law summary results are displayed in descending order by most authoritative and/or most commonly cited.
There are direct links to the full text judgment beneath each law summary.



5. Click the Show More button to see all law summary results.



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
