
Learn how to create links in your intranet, library catalogue or learning system to content in Westlaw Precision Australia.

Link to a case KeyCite record or unreported judgment

- 1. Click on the Copy menu button.
- 2. Select Copy citation.



- 3. Ensure the Add hyperlink to citation box is ticked.
- 4. Click on the Copy button and use CTRL and V to paste.



If you are a Single Sign On user, you will need to add your Group ID to the end of the URL.

Link to a law report

- 5. Ensure you are in the law report version of the case material.
- 6. Click on the Copy button and use CTRL and V to paste.



Link to a journal article

- 1. Search for the article by words in the title or citation
- 2. Click on the suggestion to locate the journal record




- 3. Click on the Copy menu button.
- 4. Select Copy citation.






- 5. Ensure the Add hyperlink to citation box is ticked.

Link to a commentary page or Laws of Australia

- 1. When on the page, click on the Copy menu.
- 2. Click on Copy citation.

- 4. Click on the Copy button and use CTRL and V to paste.



Link to a commentary's table of contents

- 1. Search for the commentary by typing in its name
- 2. Click on the suggestion to go to the table of contents




3. Click on the Copy Link button.
